### Cleveland Instruments

Combined here are instruments made by the Cleveland Musical Instrument Co (CMIC) founded in 1919 and purchased by the H.N. White Co in 1925 and Cleveland models made by White. They are arranged here based on an extensive comparison between examples found and images from catalogs or advertising. Except for what I have here as the pre-White examples, the fonts used for the serial numbers match those from King instruments. All American Standard instruments, either marked CMIC or White, use a separate serial number sequence, so a separate list is provided below this one.

Most Cleveland instruments use a serial number font matching those used by White. What I call White font #2 was used from 1914 to 1929 and font #3 from 1930 to 1956. Font #4 is from 1957 on. A column for fonts is used here to help in dating.

1921 Cleveland moved to #1469 West 3rd St mid-year.

1923 CMIC contracted out to White to meet the demand for instruments. Their fifteen workers could not keep up with production.

1925 White purchased CMIC which became a subsidiary company. Ads from this year show the trumpet still matching the design from 1920. White eventually developed a full line of models by 1928.

1928 and 1930 ads by CMIC show that a third slide ring had been added to the trumpet and match the two examples above. By 1928, they are at #1454 East 53rd St, which is a factory on the White property. White said that they had lowered the trumpet price from \$100 to \$61.50 by 1930 as this 1928 ad shows.
